Prior to IMCO, Bert was the President and CEO of Infrastructure Ontario (IO), which is responsible for managing the province of Ontario's real estate portfolio, lending to municipalities and other public-sector organizations and the delivery of large, complex public infrastructure projects. Before joining IO, Bert was the Managing Director responsible for the North American infrastructure advisory business at Scotiabank.

Bert is on the Board of Directors at C.D. Howe Institute and is the Chair of the Board of Governors at North York General Hospital.

Ian Bremmer is a political scientist who helps business leaders, policy makers, and the general public make sense of the world around them. He is President and Founder of Eurasia Group, the world's leading political risk research and consulting firm, and GZERO Media, a company dedicated to providing intelligent and engaging coverage of international affairs. Ian is an independent voice on critical issues around the globe, offering clearheaded insights and commentary.

He is the host of GZERO World with Ian Bremmer, which airs weekly on US national public television. Ian is also a frequent guest on CNN, Fox News, MSNBC, the BBC, and Bloomberg.

A prolific writer, Ian is the author of 10 books, including the New York Times bestseller "Us vs Them: The Failure of Globalism" which examines the rise of populism across the world. He also serves as the Foreign Affairs Columnist and Editor-at-Large for Time magazine. He currently teaches at Columbia University's School of International and Public Affairs and previously was a Professor at New York University.

Dominique Senequier

Founder and President, Ardian

Dominique Senequier founded the European leader and global private investment house, Ardian, as a private equity arm for AXA in 1996. In 2013, AXA Private Equity became Ardian, an employee-controlled company under the leadership of Dominique. Dominique began her career as an insurance commissioner at the French Ministry of Economy, later taking the role of Directeur Général de GAN Participations at the insurance company GAN Group.

Dominique has long recognized that finance must operate as a force for good in society. Over time, she has ensured that the company puts its core values and ideals into practice by experimenting and innovating to create a comprehensive and effective approach to sustainability. She pioneered the practice of sharing the value realized on exit with all employees of portfolio companies. Ardian's vision of sustainability is to empower individuals to collectively create sustainable value for all stakeholders. Over the past decade her conviction that Ardian must be a leader in sustainability has touched every aspect of its activities. It has changed the way Ardian invests and how the company measures the performance of its portfolio companies and the GPs in its Fund of Funds portfolio.

Dominique has won recognition internationally for her contribution to the finance industry, regularly appearing at the top of the rankings of the most powerful personalities in the world. In 2021, she was awarded the prestigious Officier de la Légion d'Honneur by the French state. She serves as a Vice-President of the Supervisory Board of the French luxury goods manufacturer, Hermès. In addition, she is a member of the French Actuarial Institute. In 2010, at Dominique's request, the Ardian Foundation was created to support important social causes. The Foundation aims to help talented young people from underprivileged backgrounds achieve their potential through higher education.

Dominique was one of the first seven women to be admitted to the École Polytechnique. She holds a Master of Advanced Studies in Banking and Monetary Economics from Université Paris-Sorbonne.

Scott Rechler

CEO and Chairman, RXR Realty

Scott Rechler leads a multi-billion dollar private real estate company that values building vibrant communities, tapping into broad ecosystems of relationships and superior stakeholder communications. RXR is one of the largest owners, managers, and developers of real estate and infrastructure in the New York metropolitan region with an aggregate gross asset value of \$20.5 billion, 25.5 million sq. ft. of commercial properties and a multi-family portfolio of 6,000 units.

Scott prides himself on building and enhancing strong communities where RXR operates. He serves as Chairman of the Regional Plan Association and is a Board member of the Real Estate Board of New York, The Feinstein Institute for Medical Research, and the NYU Real Estate Institute Advisory Committee.

From June 2011 to October 2016, Scott served on the Board of Commissioners for the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey. As Vice Chairman of the Board, and Chairman of the Port Authority's Capital Planning Committee, he had oversight responsibility for the Port's \$30 billion capital budget, including the World Trade Center redevelopment. From 2017 to 2019 Scott served on the Board of the New York Metropolitan Transportation Authority.

Scott's passion for arts and culture have led him to the Boards of America's greatest cultural institutions including the Tribeca Film Institute, Long Island Children's Museum, The National September 11 Memorial & Museum at the World Trade Center Foundation, the Drum Major Institute, the Center for Social Innovation and the Hospital for Special Surgery.

Scott is a graduate of Clark University and has a Master of Science in Real Estate from the New York University Schack Institute.

Lili Dunn joined as CIO of Bell Partners in 2010. Prior to joining Bell Partners, Lili was a 20-year veteran with AvalonBay Communities, a leading public apartment REIT and a member of the S&P 500. In her role as Managing Director at AvalonBay, she was responsible for the company's national transaction activity, which consisted of roughly 60,000 apartment units valued at approximately \$6.5 billion.

Lili is on the Executive Board of the National Multi Housing Council, Vice Chair of the multifamily council of Urban Land Institute, a member of Pension Real Estate Association, and a Board of Director for the Association of Foreign Investors in Real Estate.

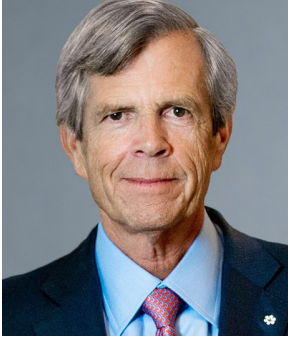
